5. If you lose this page, you can download a copy from the FBA website.

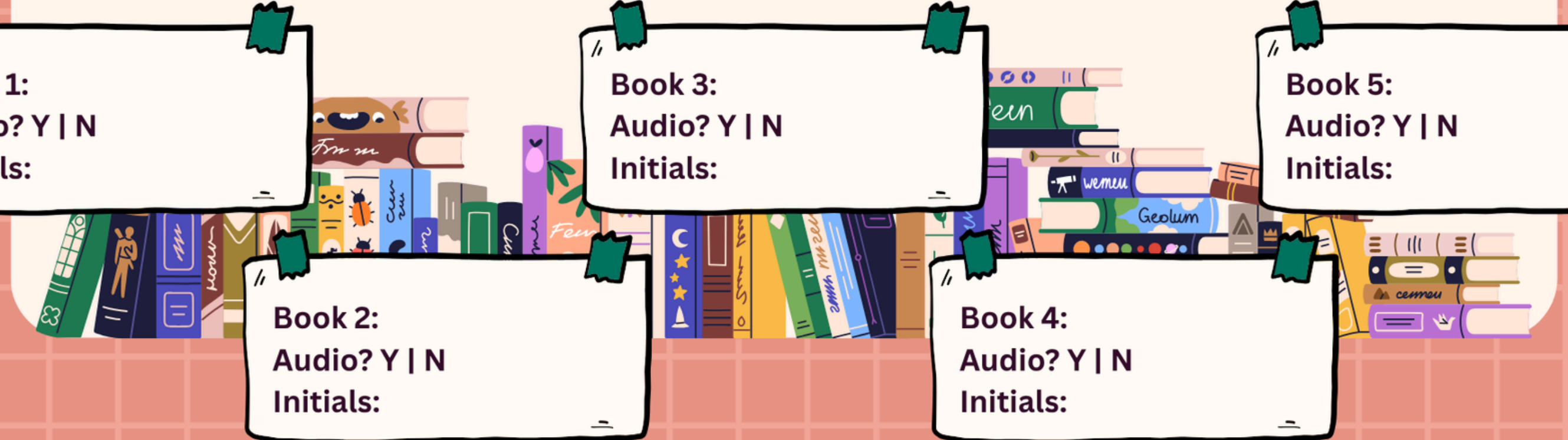

Each book you read may only be used once. You may use your 5 required books here; *additional* books can be any level, genre, audio or written, etc. ***

 You must have the **book read, initialed**, and the **activity completed**, to have the square counted. One unique book per square.
- 
 To **submit completed activities**, you may attach physical copies to this sheet (NOTE: required reading front page = physical submission only) when turning it in **or** you may post* the activities on your class Teams page to share our creativity! No AI. *If you choose to Teams post activities, please only post once + add any more activities as comments on your 1 post.
- 
 Each completed square is worth one **class point** and counts only once for class point tallying. These contribute to your class points average for the Summer Reading Party class competition.
- 
 Bingos earn **homework passes (HWP)****.
 1 Bingo = 1 HWP | 2 Bingos = 2 HWP
 3 Bingos = 3 HWP | Blackout = 4 HWP
 **Each subject can have only one homework pass used on it per quarter. Homework passes may be used before homework is collected or retroactively after grading. Students can be awarded a maximum of 4 passes.
